



Cookie Policy

Purpose

The "Website" (www.umbriaholidays.com) uses cookies to make it a simple and efficient services for users who its pages.

Information pursuant to art. 13 d. lgs. 196/2003 and of the Regulations EU 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (GDPR). Pursuant to art. 13 d. lgs. 196/2003 (hereinafter T.U.) and of the EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (GDPR), Prato di Sotto informs you as follows:

1. Technical cookies

This type of cookie allows the proper functioning of some sections of the site. They are of two categories: persistent and session: persistent: once closed the browser is not destroyed but remains up to a pre-set session expiration date: they are destroyed every time the browser is closed These cookies, always sent from our domain, they are necessary to view the site correctly and in relation to the technical services offered, they will therefore always be used and sent, unless the user changes the settings in his / her own browser (thus disrupting the display of site pages).

2. Analytical cookies

Cookies in this category are used to collect information on the use of the site. www.umbriaholidays.com will use this information in on anonymous statistical analysis to improve use of the site and to make the contents more interesting and relevant to the users. This type of cookie collects data in an anonymous form on the activity of users and how they arrived on the site.

3. Analysis cookies for third party services

These cookies are used to gather information on use of the site by users in anonymous form such as: pages visited, residence, time, origins of traffic, geographical location, age, gender and interests for the purpose of marketing campaigns. These cookies are sent from third-party domains external to the site.

4. Cookies for integrating software products and functions third party

This type of cookie integrates developed features from third parties within the pages of the site such as icons and preferences expressed in social networks in order to share the contents of the site or for the use of third-party software services (such as software to generate maps and additional software that offer additional services). These cookies are sent from third-party domains and from partner sites that offer their functionality between the pages of the site.



5. Profiling cookies

These cookies are necessary to create user profiles in order to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user within the pages of the site. www.umbriaholidays.com, according to the law in force, it is not required to seek consent for technical cookies and cookie analytics, as necessary to provide the required services. For all the other types of cookies the consent can be expressed by the user with one or more of the following methods:

- By specific configurations in the browser used
- In the related computer programs used to browse the pages that make up the site

By changing the settings in the use of third-party services may prevent the user from using or viewing parts of the website.

The site may contain links to other sites that have their own privacy policy which may be different from that adopted by www.umbriaholidays.com and that which therefore does not respond to these sites.
